ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

1. **Crosier Jubilee Week and Extraordinary General Chapter:**
 - From 8-14 September, Saint Agatha's Crosier Priory will be the heart and centre of the Crosier Jubilee Week, and of an Extraordinary General Chapter as essential part of the Jubilee.
 - Two committees, a General Jubilee Committee & a General Chapter Planning Committee, are working and finalizing their respective planning and preparation activities.
 - Next to 36 Capitulars, Periti & Staff members, a significant number of other Crosiers from the worldwide Order, and an international group of Jubilee Guests will participate in Jubilee Activities (fully or partially). The Jubilee Committee has conveyed information about Jubilee Week arrangements, proper to the interest of these respective Crosiers and Jubilee Guests.
 - As has been communicated already: all Crosiers and Jubilee Guests are invited for the Jubilee Reflection Day on Thursday 9 September 2010. On Monday 13 September 2010 in the afternoon, and Tuesday 14 September 2010, Chapter Assemblies are proposed to be open for all Crosiers and Jubilee Guests.
 - While capitulars, periti and staff will be at chapter, on Friday 10 September, and Saturday 11 September, other Crosiers and Jubilee Guests will take part in Jubilee Activities, organized by the General Jubilee Committee, in particular two Crosier Tour Days to respectively "Kloster Bentlage" (Germany), and Maaseik, Kolen-Kerniel, Maastricht (Belgium & the Netherlands).
 - On Sunday 12 September 2010, all Crosiers host an Open Crosier House at Saint Agatha. It is expected that particularly in the afternoon, many people will join the Order and rejoice with us in our Great Jubilee. On Tuesday 14 September 2010, Church Leaders and Religious celebrate with us the Solemnity of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross.
2. **Housing for capitulars, periti and staff:**
 - Every capitular, peritus and staff member will have a personal room (in Hotel or Priory).
 - Since space for housing in Saint Agatha's Priory is somehow limited, a number of capitulars and periti will be staying at Van der Valk Hotel in Cuijk. See list of room assignments above.
 - Rooms at Saint Agatha's Priory are ready. Reservations for Hotel rooms are made as well.
 - Arrival at and Departure from Hotel:
 - Check-in date: Wednesday 8 September 2010.
 - Check-out date: Wednesday 15 September 2010 (before noon).
 - Costs for the Hotel room and the breakfast are covered by the General Chapter Budget.
 - Hotel payment arrangements for Capitulars and Periti will be made.
3. **Early arrivals and/or late departures of capitulars, periti and staff:**
 - Capitulars and Periti staying at the Hotel, and arriving earlier than 8 September in, or departing later than 15 September from the Saint Agatha area, are kindly requested to communicate as soon as possible additional needs for housing, being aware however that we are limited in ability to adequately respond additional housing needs. It is therefore recommended to respect the scheduled dates for Hotel *check-in* and *check-out*.
 - All rooms in the Priory of Saint Agatha will be prepared and reserved for hosting and housing the confreres assigned to stay at the Priory during the Jubilee Week and the Extraordinary General Chapter. For those housed in the Priory, arrival and departure are more flexible.
4. **Meals:** capitulars and periti, staying at the Hotel, will have breakfast at the Hotel (available from 6.30AM on). For those staying at the Priory, breakfast will be served at the Priory (available from 7.00AM on). All other meals (lunch and dinner), coffee breaks and socials will be organized at the Priory (catering service).
5. **Laundry:** the Hotel provides a daily laundry service. The Priory offers laundry service as well. Details about practical laundry arrangements in the Priory will be communicated upon arrival.
6. **Transport:** for capitulars and periti, staying at the Hotel, transportation is provided for by the General Chapter Staff. Two larger vans are available, with drivers, to assure a comfortable shuttle service between Hotel – Priory – Hotel.
